All 1 & 2 Person HH's who pass the Net Income Test and Elderly Disabled HH's with Income At or Under the 200% FPL will receive the **Minimum Allotment** of \$16. In the application month the \$16 allotment will be pro-rated.

Medicare Part B Premium for Recipients = \$104.90 for one

Current Medicare Part B Premium for Recipients = \$209.80 for a couple

Part B for new Enrollees as of 2016 = \$121.80 for one

Part B for new Enrollees as of 2016 = \$243.60 for a couple

Allowable CalFresh Exclusions/Deductions Effective 10/1/2016 – 9/30/2017

Exclusion for Court Ordered Child Support Paid to child outside the home	Court ordered amount or amount paid, whichever is less, is excluded prior to computing gross test
Earned Income	20% deducted from gross income
Excess Medical	Amount over \$35 for Elderly/Disabled HH members
Standard Deduction	\$157 (1-3) \$168 (4) \$197 (5) \$226 (6+)
Dependent Care (current amount only)	Allow full amount paid/billed per child
Maximum Excess Shelter	\$517 No Max Shelter for Elderly/Disabled
Homeless Shelter	\$143
SUAS	\$389
SUA – Standard Utility Allowance	\$389 - must pay for Heating and/or Cooling
LUA – Limited Utility Allowance	\$122 - HH pays for 2 utility costs other than heating and/or cooling
TUA – Telephone Utility Allowance	\$19 – Landline, cell phone, or internet phone
